

Conflict Management: Student-to-Student

Estimated time to complete: 20 minutes

Course Description

SafeSchools Conflict Management: Student to Student course is specifically designed for school administrators, teachers and other school staff who may need to help two students resolve a conflict. The focus, whenever possible, is on leveraging simple mediation techniques which allow the adult to assist students in solving their own conflict. The course helps the staff member facilitate solutions to common problems. In addition, the course provides basic training in differentiating between common conflicts (in which adult mediation may be effective) and potentially dangerous situations such as bullying, sexual harassment, threats of violence, etc. (in which escalation may be required.)

- Staff members help students solve their own conflicts, when possible
- Includes two interactive scenarios illustrating correct and incorrect responses
- Differentiates between common conflicts and dangerous situations
